#### **Presenters**

**Ron** Ang is the general manager of the Skylark Shores Resort, Lakeport, CA.

**Dr. Stephen Bateman** owns Chocks Away Aviation. He led the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association's flying club initiative, is an FAA certified flight instructor, a FAASTeam Lead Safety Representative and holds a PhD in electrical engineering.

**Bruce Bolla** is a retired United Airlines pilot. He holds a Gold Seal flight instructor certificate, received the Master Pilot Award and is currently teaching light sport amphibious aircraft in California. Bruce has flown air tours out of San Francisco Bay in a DHC-2 Beaver and has been an aviation guest lecturer at UC Berkeley.

**Chris Brown** was President and Chief Pilot of Centurion Flight Services, a Palo based firm that operates 11 aircraft. Chris has over 36,000 hours of flight time. He owns two Cessna 206 aircraft, one on straight floats and one on amphibious floats for over 40 years. Chris spent one season flying float planes from Lake Hood Seaplane Base (PALH) including the De Havilland Beaver, Cessna 185 and Cessna 206 on floats.

Kim Costa is the Mayor of the City of Lakeport, and a member of the Lakeport City Council. In her capacity as a council member she serves as the council representative to the Lake County Chamber of Commerce, the Lake County Recreation Authority and the Lake County Risk Reduction Authority. She also serves as a program manager with the Lake County Department of Social Service's Children Services Division.

**Terry Hayes** is a gold seal CFI instructing in single and multi-engine seaplanes. She owned NorCal Aviation, a float flying service in Angels Camp, CA for 15 years. While she owned NorCal Aviation she served as a FAA Designated Pilot Examiner. She currently works for Back Country Flying Experience, flying charters and providing seaplane training in Montana and California.

Brian Hylland is the Product Development Manager of Bellingham Marine. Brian was the Sales Director of Seaflex for over 10 years.

**Tod Dickey** is the Arizona Regional Director of the Seaplane Pilots Association. He has extensive experience flying the Grumman Widgeon.

Herb Lingl is a commercial single and multi-engine land and seaplane pilot and the education director of the Clear Lake Flying Club.

Amanda Martin is the Executive Director of the Lake County Chamber of Commerce.

**Steve McCaughey** is the Executive Director of the Seaplane Pilots Association. He is type rated in the Grumman HU016 Albatross and has conducted over 750 aviation safety workshops.

**Frankie Ridolfi** is an experienced Super Petrel pilot and president of the Oakland, CA Experimental Aircraft Association Chapter. He is certified by the Federal Aviation Administration as a Light-Sport Airplane Repairman with Maintenance Rating.

**Alberto Rossi** is the owner of Rossi Aircraft, Inc which has been supporting the Palo Alto aviation community for over 30 years. He has over 700 hours flying the Cessna 185 on floats.
